IMPORTANT INFORMATION - OVERVIEW

Visual and Heritage Arts

- ? **Label all artwork** with YOUR Name and Phone Number! Label should be removable for judging.
- ? **Only one entry per subcategory** (designated by artist) is considered for judging. Additional entries are welcome for the showcase and may be eligible for local recognition.
- ? All Visual and Heritage Arts must be **checked in** at Eden Town Hall between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Friday, May 4. Entries must be **picked up** before 4 p.m. May 11 at Eden Town Hall. To pick up artwork, you must present the receipt given at check-in. **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED BEFORE MAY 11!**
- ? **Wrap/package artwork** carefully to prevent damage!
- ? Entries must be the original work of the artist, must be a work created after the artist is age 55, and must have been completed within 2 years of the Local Games' qualifying date.

Literary Arts

- ? Literary Arts Entries must be **turned in with registration form** in the format indicated on the "Specific Requirements" page.
- ? **Only one entry per subcategory** (designated by artist) is considered for judging. Additional entries are welcome for the showcase and may be eligible for local recognition.
- ? Only one copy is required for the local games.
- ? Entries must be the original work of the artist, must be a work created after the artist is age 55, and must have been completed within 2 years of the Local Games' qualifying date.

Performing Arts

- ? Performing Artists will **compete** at the Awards Luncheon on **May 11**.
- ? At least one representative from each performance **must attend rehearsal** at **1:30pm May 10**. This is a "dry run" to know staging, performance order, etc.
- ? No one under the age of 55 will be permitted to perform on stage.
- ? **All performers/accompanists** must be registered participants.
